The Burrillville School Department is committed to providing its students with a combination of tools and technical resources to support engagement and learning in the 21st century. With the proliferation of technology in our schools and classrooms, more and more digital content is being used with instruction.

While the district has been successful in providing opportunities to leverage these resources, we feel that now is an important time to request that students have pairs of headphones/earbuds to keep at school. These can be used with classroom computers, laptops, mobile devices, or taken to computer labs.

There are many advantages to students having their own headphones/earbuds in school, including practicing better hygiene, greater availability and access, and more personal choice in terms of style and comfort.

Teachers are prepared to designate space in the classrooms for students to store their headphones. The students will be provided with Ziploc bags with their names on them for easy identification and retrieval.

We ask that over the next month each student please bring in a pair of wired headphones/ earbuds to keep in the classroom. The headphones/earbuds must be wired (no wireless, no Bluetooth), and connect to a traditional 3.5mm headphone jack. They are most often less than \$10 in cost.
